Terms of Competition Junior Golf Tour – 18-Hole Stroke Play

Eligibility

Eligible to participate are amateur golfers (girls and boys with an HCPI of no more than 29.9) born in **2004 or later**, who are members of a recognised DGV member club or of a foreign golf club affiliated with its respective national golf association.

Conditions of Play

Play will be conducted in accordance with the Official Rules of Golf (including the Rules of Amateur Status) of the German Golf Association (Deutscher Golf Verband e.V. – DGV).

The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the Handicap Rules (World Handicap System) and will be handicap-relevant.

These association regulations may be inspected at the tournament venue's administration office.

Entries

Entries may only be submitted via www.jgt24.de.

Starting places will be allocated on a “**FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED**” basis. If the number of entries exceeds the maximum number of participants stated in the tournament announcement, waiting lists will be maintained.

The Junior Golf Tour reserves the right to award wildcards and to admit players to the field who do not meet these eligibility requirements.

Format of Play

Individual – 54-hole stroke play over three tournament rounds, without a cut.

Ties

In the event of a tie in the overall Championship classification, first place will be decided by a play-off. The Tournament Committee will determine the holes to be used for the play-off.

All age-group placings will be determined by scorecard countback. In the event of equal scores, the result will be determined mathematically based on the last 36, 18, 9 and 3 holes, in that order. If the players are still tied, the placing will be decided by lot.

Entry Fee

EUR 205.00 for the 54-hole competition.

The entry fee includes one practice round, three tournament rounds, a limited number of range balls, water, fruit and the prize-giving ceremony.

Withdrawal / Cancellation

If a participant no longer wishes to take part in the event, the participant must notify the organiser of the withdrawal from the contract in writing or by e-mail.

In the event of withdrawal/cancellation up to 30 days before the start of the event, the participation fee will be refunded less a 20% administration fee.

In the event of withdrawal/cancellation from 29 days before the event up to the entry deadline, the participation fee will be refunded less a 40% administration fee.

No refund will be made for withdrawals/cancellations after the entry deadline. The entry deadline is always **10:00 a.m. on the day of the practice round**.

Classification

1st place – Championship: 54 holes (3 × 18 holes), with separate classifications for girls and boys.

1st–3rd place in each age group: Age Groups 23, 21, 18, 16 and 14, depending on participation numbers, with separate classifications for girls and boys.

The Tournament Committee will designate one hole for the special “**Hole-in-One**” competition. The first hole-in-one recorded on this hole, with girls and boys competing in one combined classification, will win a non-cash prize.

Team Competition

In addition to the individual classifications, a 54-hole team competition will be held.

A team consists of a maximum of four female and/or male players from the same golf club. Teams may be made up of players of different genders and age groups. Players in Age Group 12 are excluded from the team competition.

For each tournament round, the three best individual scores of a team will count towards the team result. The overall result is calculated from the sum of the counting scores from all three tournament rounds.

In the event of a tie, the tie-breaking procedure used for the individual classification will apply.

Order of Merit

An Order of Merit will be maintained throughout the entire season. Players will receive Order of Merit points for participating in the individual tournaments, with the number of points awarded depending on their respective finishing position. Points will be awarded in accordance with the points system established by the Junior Golf Tour.

Separate Orders of Merit will be maintained for girls and boys. At the end of the season, the player finishing first in the **Order of Merit Boys** and the player finishing first in the **Order of Merit Girls** will each receive a prize.

Team Order of Merit

In addition, a **Team Order of Merit** will be maintained throughout the entire season as a club competition. At each tournament, up to four players from the same golf club will form a team and will be ranked in a separate team classification.

Depending on the team's finishing position, the respective golf club will receive points towards the Team Order of Merit. The points earned at the individual tournaments will be accumulated for the golf club throughout the season. The composition of the team may vary from tournament to tournament. The determining factor is that all players belong to the same golf club.

At the end of the season, the golf club finishing first in the Team Order of Merit will receive a prize.

Prize-Giving Ceremony

The competition officially concludes with the prize-giving ceremony. Winners who are not present at the prize-giving ceremony will not receive their prizes.

Prizes will not be passed on to other participants, sent by post, or handed over to third parties for onward delivery.

Caddies

Caddies are permitted following registration at the organiser's office.

Caddies are required to comply with the Rules of Golf as well as all course and tournament regulations. Caddies must be clearly identifiable by wearing a **caddie bib**.

The applicable rules are available as a PDF in the Downloads section.

Distance-Measuring Devices and E-Trolleys

Distance-measuring devices are permitted.

Electric trolleys are permitted.

Live Scoring

Before teeing off, the players in each group must agree on who will be responsible for live scoring. If no agreement can be reached, the starter or the Tournament Committee will appoint the person responsible for live scoring. Where technically possible, scores will be entered during the round via the tournament app (**Golfbox**). If technical limitations prevent the use of live scoring, there is no obligation to enter scores electronically. The signed scorecard remains the official and binding record.

Spectators

Spectators are welcome on the golf course.

They must maintain a minimum distance of **50 metres** from the playing groups at all times.

Notice Regarding the Publication of Videos and Photographs

As a sporting event organiser, we would like to present and report on the sporting activities associated with our events on our website, on the internet and in other media, such as daily newspapers or brochures. For this purpose, we may use videos and photographs taken during the tournament in which your children may be individually identifiable.
